Everyone is required to read **300 pages** minimum. You can read books, magazines, anything you like. You then need to answer the following questions. Your report can be typed or handwritten. Choose one book that you have read over the summer to complete the following questions. Follow the directions carefully. Each question must be answered in a complete paragraph (8-11 sentences). Be sure to add as many details as you can.

1. Title of Book
2. Author
3. Write a summary of the book.
4. Describe the setting of the story. Where did your story take place?
5. What was the most exciting moment in the book? Why?
6. When you got to the end of the book, did you wish that it didn't end? What do you think should or would happen next?
7. Find 3 new words in the books or magazines that you have been reading over the summer. List the three words with their definitions.

If you choose to read a magazine, answer the following questions:

1. Magazine
2. Number of pages
3. Why did you choose this magazine or article?
4. What did you learn?
